Embracing the notion that plants and animals are our oldest teachers, Kimmerer shows that the awakening of a wider ecological consciousness requires the acknowledgment and celebration of our reciprocal relationship with the rest of the living world.

As a mother, scientist, professor, and enrolled member of the Citizen Potawatomi Nation, Kimmerer’s first book *Gathering Moss*, was awarded the John Burroughs Medal for outstanding nature writing. Her writings have appeared in *Orion*, *O Magazine*, and numerous scientific journals. She lives in Fabius, New York, where she is SUNY Distinguished Teaching Professor of Environmental Biology, and the founder and director of the Center for Native Peoples and Environment.
