**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Aquinnah who are qualified to vote in elections and town affairs to meet at the Aquinnah Town Hall of said Town on the Fifth day of June, 2018 at 7:00 P.M., then and there to act upon the articles of this Warrant.

**ARTICLE ONE:**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the total sum of Thirty-five Thousand Forty Three Dollars and Twenty-eight cents (\$35,043.18) from the Town Building & Grounds Stabilization Fund stabilization fund to the General Stabilization Fund, or take any other action relative thereto.. **(Two-thirds vote required).**

**ARTICLE TWO:**


To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of Thirty-three Thousand Six Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Thirteen Cents (\$33,613.13) from the General Stabilization Fund to pay the Town's share of the costs to repair the heating system at the Chilmark School, or take any other action relative thereto. **(Two-thirds vote required).**


**ARTICLE THREE:**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Dollars and Five Cents (\$1,430.05) from the General Stabilization Fund to pay the Town's share of the costs to install fire alarms at the West Tisbury School, or take any other action relative thereto. **(Two-thirds vote required).**


And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copies at the Schoolhouse/Library and Town Hall in said Town at least fourteen days prior to time of said meeting. Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of said meeting.
